SECTION I

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDER

GENERAL

1. **Scope of Bid**

The Sri Lanka Cricket Procurement Committee (DPC) issues these Bidding Documents for the supply of Junior Cricket Equipment to the Sri Lanka Cricket.

2. **Source of Funds**

Payments under this contract will be financed by the Sri Lanka Cricket.

3. <u>Eligible Bidders</u>

- 3.1 All bidders shall possess legal rights to supply the Goods under this contract.
- 3.2 All bidders must prove the financial stability, qualifications and experience to perform the Contract by providing the necessary details/reports as acceptable to the Sri Lanka Cricket.
- 3.3 In the case of a Bidder not doing business within Sri Lanka, the Bidder shall be (if awarded the Contract) represented by an Agent in that country who is equipped and able to carry out the required supplies services including the Bidder's maintenance, technical support, training, and repair obligations prescribed in the Contract, and/or Technical Requirements.
- 3.4 A Bidder shall not have a conflict of interest. All bidders found to have conflict of interest shall be disqualified. Bidders may be considered to have a conflict of interest with one or more parties in this bidding process, if they:
 - (a) Are or have been associated in the past, with a firm or any of its affiliates which have been engaged by the Sri Lanka Cricket to provide consulting services for the preparation of the design, specifications, and other documents to be used for the procurement of the goods to be purchased under these Bidding Documents; or
 - (b) Submit more than one bid in this bidding process.
- 3.5 A Bidder that is under a declaration of ineligibility by the National Procurement Agency (NPA), at the date of submission of bids or at the date of contract award, shall be disqualified. The list of debarred firms is available at the website of NPA, www.npa.gov.lk.
- 3.6 Foreign Bidder may submit a bid on CIF basis.

4. <u>Eligible Goods and Related Services</u>

4.1 All goods supplied under this contract shall be complied with the given specification in absence of such specifications the goods shall comply with any other applicable standards stipulated by the Sri Lanka Standards Institute (SLSI) or other internationally accepted standards.

CONTENTS OF BIDDING DOCUMENTS

5. <u>Sections of Bidding Documents</u>

5.1 The Bidding Documents consist of 2 Volumes, which include all the sections indicated below,

- Section IV. Bidding Forms
- Section V. Price Schedule
- Section VI. Technical Specifications
- 5.2 The Bidder is expected to examine all instructions, forms, terms, and specifications in the Bidding Documents. Failure to furnish all information or documentation required by the Bidding Documents may result in the rejection of the bid.

6. Clarification of Bidding Documents

6.1 An eligible Bidder requiring any clarification of the Bidding Documents including the restrictiveness of specifications shall contact the Sri Lanka Cricket in writing at the Sri Lanka Cricket address specified in the BDS. The Sri Lanka Cricket will respond in writing to any request for clarification to the respective bidder. Such clarifications shall be made prior to Ten (10) days to deadline for submission of bids.

7. <u>Amendment of Bidding Documents</u>

7.1 At any time five days prior to the deadline for submission of bids, the Sri Lanka Cricket may amend the Bidding Documents by publishing an addendum in the Sri Lanka Cricket Website (http://www.srilankacricket.lk/). As such, all eligible bidders as per ITB Clause 4.0 shall refer to the Sri Lanka Cricket website (http://www.srilankacricket.lk/) on frequent manner until the deadline of submission of bids to make the bid in fully compliance to any new requirement given in any such addendum.

PREPARATION OF BIDS

8. **Preparation of Bid**

8.1 All eligible bidders shall obtain the Bid Document from Sri Lanka Cricket or download a copy of this Bidding Document from the Sri Lanka Cricket website (http://www.srilankacricket.lk/) and prices are required to be indicated in Section V. Price Schedule. The sealed tenders, in duplicate, shall be addressed to "Chief Executive Officer, Sri Lanka Cricket, No 35, Maitland Place, Colombo 07. And may be either dispatched by Registered Post or deposited in the Tender Box, at the Administration Department, Sri Lanka Cricket, No 35, Maitland Place, Colombo 07 well before the closing time. Late bids and bids submitted on E-form will not be accepted.

9. **Language of Bid**

9.1 The Bid, as well as all correspondence and documents relating to the Bid (including supporting documents and printed literature) exchanged by the Bidder and the Sri Lanka Cricket, shall be written in English or Sinhala language .

10. Documents Comprising the Bid

- 10.1 The Bid shall comprise the following:
- (a) Bid Submission Form and the applicable Price Schedules.
- (b) Bid Security Form.
- (c) Documentary evidence in accordance that the Goods and Related Services conform to the Bidding Documents;
- (d) The offer shall be submitted with original Certificates, Manufacturer's Authorizations, Catalogues, brochures, warranty certificates and technical details.
- (e) Any other document required in the BDS.

11. Bid Submission Form and Price Schedules

11.1 **The Bidder shall submit the Bid Submission Form using the form furnished in Section IV, Bidding Forms**. This form must be completed without any alterations to its format, and no substitutes shall be accepted. All blank spaces shall be filled in with the information requested.

12. Alternative Bids

12.1 **Alternative bids shall not be considered.** Only two offers (same brand) from each supplier/manufacture will be accepted. Any additional offers from different brands shall accompany a separate Bid Bond. If not the bid may be rejected.

13. <u>Bid Prices and Discounts</u>

- 13.1 The Bidder shall indicate on the Price Schedule provided in Section V the unit prices and total bid prices of the Goods it proposes to supply under the Contract.
- 13.2 Any discount offered against any single item in the price schedule shall be included in the unit price of the item. However, a Bidder wishes to offer discount as a lot the bidder may do so by indicating such amounts appropriately.

13.3 Goods supplied from outside the Purchaser's country:

The prices shall be quoted on a CIF (Sea Port/Airport Colombo) basis, exclusive of all taxes, stamps, duties, levies, and fees imposed in the Purchaser's country. However, it is mandatory that FOB/FCA price, freight charges and Insurance be indicated separately as provided in the Price Schedule in Section V. The named place of destination shall be Sea Port Colombo or Airport Colombo and special instructions for the contract of carriage are as **specified in the BDS**. The Bidder may obtain insurance services from any eligible source of his country.

- 13.4 The Prices quoted by the Bidder shall be fixed during the Bidder's performance of the Contract and not subject to variation on any account. A bid submitted with an adjustable price quotation will be treated as non-responsive and rejected.
- 13.5 All lots, if any, and items must be listed and priced separately in the Price Schedules. If a Price Schedule shows items listed but not priced, their prices shall be assumed to be included in the prices of other items.

14. **Currencies of Bid**

14.1 Unless otherwise stated in Bidding Data Sheet, the Bidder shall quote in Sri Lankan Rupees and payment shall be payable only in Sri Lanka Rupees.

Foreign bidders should be quoted CIF price & not FOB.

15. <u>Documents Establishing the Eligibility of the Bidder</u>

15.1 To establish their eligibility, Bidders shall complete the Bid Submission Form, included in Section IV, Bidding Forms.

16. Documents Establishing the Conformity of the Goods and Related Services

16.1 To establish the conformity of the Goods and Related Services to the Bidding Documents, the Bidder shall furnish as part of its Bid the documentary evidence that the Goods conform to the technical specifications and standards specified in Section VI, Technical specifications.

17. <u>Period of Validity of Bids</u>

17.1 Bids shall remain valid until the date specified in the BDS. A bid valid for a shorter date shall be rejected by the Sri Lanka Cricket as non-responsive.

18. **Bid Security**

18.1 The Bidder shall furnish as part of its bid, a Bid Security, as specified in the BDS.

- 18.2 The Bid Security shall be in the amount specified in the BDS and shall:
 - (a) At the bidder's option, be in the form of a bank draft, a letter of credit, or a bank guarantee from a banking institution;
 - (b) Be issued by an institution acceptable to Sri Lanka Cricket. The acceptable institutes are published in the NPA website, www.npa.gov.lk.
 - (c) Be substantially in accordance with the form included in Section IV, Bidding Forms;
 - (d) Be payable promptly upon first written demand by the Sri Lanka Cricket in case the conditions listed in ITB Clause 19.5 are invoked;
 - (e) Be submitted in its original form; copies will not be accepted;
 - (f) Remain valid for the period specified in the BDS.
- 18.3 Any bid not accompanied by a substantially responsive Bid Security in accordance with ITB Sub-Clause 18.1 and 18.2, may be rejected by the Sri Lanka Cricket as non-responsive.
- 18.4 The Bid Security may be forfeited:
 - (a) If a Bidder withdraws its bid during the period of bid validity specified by the Bidder on the Bid Submission Form, except as provided in ITB Sub- Clause 18.2; or
 - (b) If a Bidder does not agreeing to correction of arithmetical errors in pursuant to ITB Sub-Clause 35.3
 - (c) If the successful Bidder fails to:
 - (i) Sign the Contract in accordance with ITB Clause 43;
 - (ii) Furnish a Performance Security in accordance with ITB Clause 44.
- 18.5 Any guarantee from a foreign bank shall be advised through a State Bank operating in Sri Lanka with a counter guarantee.

19. Format and Signing of Bid

- 19.1 The Bidder shall prepare one original of the documents comprising the bid and clearly mark it as "ORIGINAL." In addition, the Bidder shall submit a copy of the bid and clearly mark it as "COPY." In the event of any discrepancy between the original and the copy, the original shall prevail.
- 19.2 The original and the Copy of the bid shall be typed or written in indelible ink and shall be signed by a person duly authorized to sign on behalf of the Bidder.
- 19.3 Any interlineations, erasures, or overwriting shall be valid only if they are signed or initialed by the person signing the Bid.

20. Payment

- 20.1 If quoted in foreign currency, payment against each order placed during the Contractor's performance will be made either by means of a Documentary Letter of Credit or Telegraphic Transfer.
- 20.2 If quoted in Sri Lanka Rupees, the payment will be effected on receipt and acceptance of Goods by the Sri Lanka Cricket along with duly completed invoice. (30 days credit facility is required after receipt of the above document)
- 20.3 Advance payment will be considered only on an Advance Payment guarantee.

SUBMISSION AND OPENING OF BIDS

21. Submission of Bids

- 21.1 Bidders may always submit their bids by courier, registered post or by hand.
 - (a) Bidders submitting bids by courier, registered post or by hand, shall enclose the original and the copy of the Bid in separate sealed envelopes, duly marking the envelopes as "ORIGINAL" and "COPY." These envelopes containing the original and the copy shall then be enclosed in one single envelope.

22. Deadline for Submission of Bids

- 22.1 Bids must be received by the Sri Lanka Cricket at the address and no later than the date and time specified in the BDS.
- 22.2 The Sri Lanka Cricket may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of bids by amending the Bidding Documents in accordance with ITB in which case all rights and obligations of the Sri Lanka Cricket and Bidders previously subject to the deadline shall thereafter be subject to the deadline as extended.

23. Late Bids

23.1 The Sri Lanka Cricket shall not consider any bid that arrives after the deadline for submission of bids. Any bid received by the Sri Lanka Cricket after the deadline for submission of bids shall be declared late, rejected, and returned unopened to the Bidder.

24. Samples

- 24.1 If specified at BDS, samples shall be submitted as specified in the BDS along with the details of samples so submitted and handed over to Manager Administration, Sri Lanka Cricket or to the Officer nominated by the CEO.
- 24.2 If a Bidder shall make more than one offer from a same brand or alternative offers, samples shall be submitted in respect of each alternative offer.

25. **Bid Opening**

- 25.1 The Sri Lanka Cricket shall conduct the bid opening in public at the address, date and time specified in the BDS.
- 25.2 All envelopes shall be opened one at a time, reading out: the name of the Bidder and whether there is a modification; the Bid Prices, including any discounts and alternative offers; the presence of a Bid Security, if required; and any other details as the Sri Lanka Cricket. Only discounts and alternative offers read out at Bid opening shall be considered for evaluation. No Bid shall be rejected at Bid opening except for late bids.
- 25.3 The Sri Lanka Cricket shall prepare a record of the Bid opening that shall include, the Bid Price, per lot if applicable, including any discounts, and the presence or absence of a Bid Security. The bids that were opened shall be resealed in separate envelopes, promptly after the bid opening. The Bidders' representatives who are present shall be requested to sign the attendance sheet. A copy of the record shall be distributed to all Bidders who submitted bids in time.

26. **Default**

26.1 In the event that the Supplier is unable to deliver Goods demanded by the Sri Lanka Cricket within the period specified therein, a sum amounting to liquidated damages shall be recovered at the rate of One – Tenth (1/10) of one percent (01%) of total cost of the delayed good or services for every day of delay, subjected to a maximum 10% of total contract value. However, if the SLC has failed to effect the payments in the timely manner above delay charges will be charged only for the balance number of days, having set off number of days delayed by the Seller against the number of days, payments are delayed by the SLC.(If any).

EVALUATION AND COMPARISON OF BIDS

27. **Confidentiality**

- 27.1 Information relating to the examination, evaluation, comparison, and post-qualification (if applicable) of bids, and recommendation of contract award, shall not be disclosed to bidders or any other persons not officially concerned with such process until publication of the Contract Award.
- 27.2 Any effort by a Bidder to influence the Sri Lanka Cricket in the examination, evaluation, comparison, and post-qualification of the bids or contract award decisions may result in the rejection of its Bid.
- 27.3 If any Bidder wishes to contact the Sri Lanka Cricket on any matter related to the bidding process, from the time of bid opening to the time of Contract Award, it should do so in writing.

28. Clarification of Bids

28.1 To assist in the examination, evaluation, comparison and post-qualification of the bids, the Sri Lanka Cricket may, at its discretion, request any Bidder for a clarification of its Bid. Any clarification submitted by a Bidder in respect to its Bid and that is not in response to a request by the Sri Lanka Cricket shall not be considered for purpose of evaluation. The Sri Lanka Cricket's request for clarification and the response shall be in writing. No change in the prices or substance of the Bid shall be sought, offered, or permitted, except to confirm the correction of arithmetic errors discovered by the Sri Lanka Cricket in the Evaluation of the bids.

29. Responsiveness of Bids

29.1 If a bid is not substantially responsive to the Bidding Documents, it shall be rejected by the Sri Lanka Cricket and may not subsequently be made responsive by the Bidder by correction of the material deviation, reservation, or omission.

30. Preliminary Examination of Bids

- 30.1 The Sri Lanka Cricket shall examine the bids to confirm that all documents and technical documentation requested in ITB Clause 11 have been provided, and to determine the completeness of each document submitted.
- 30.2 The Sri Lanka Cricket shall confirm that the following documents and information have been provided in the Bid. If any of these documents or information is missing, the Bid shall be rejected.
 - (a) Bid Submission Form
 - (b) Price Schedules
 - (c) Bid Security

31. Examination of Terms and Conditions; Technical Evaluation

- 31.1 The Sri Lanka Cricket shall examine the Bid to confirm that all terms and conditions have been accepted by the Bidder without any material deviation or reservation.
- 31.2 The Sri Lanka Cricket shall evaluate the technical aspects of the Bid submitted in accordance, to confirm that all requirements specified in Section V, Price Schedule of the Bidding Documents have been met without any material deviation or reservation.
- 31.3 If, after the examination of the terms and conditions and the technical evaluation, the Sri Lanka Cricket determines that the Bid is not substantially responsive, the Sri Lanka Cricket shall reject the Bid.

32. Sri Lanka Cricket Right to Accept Any Bid, and to Reject Any or All Bids

32.1 The Sri Lanka Cricket reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, and to annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to Bidders.

AWARD OF CONTRACT

33. Award Criteria

33.1 The Sri Lanka Cricket shall award the Contract to the Bidder whose offer has been determined to be the lowest evaluated bid and is substantially responsive to the Bidding Documents, provided further that the Bidder is determined to be qualified to perform the Contract satisfactorily.

34. Sri Lanka Cricket Right to Vary Quantities at Time of Award

34.1 At the time the Contract is awarded, the Sri Lanka Cricket reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity of Goods and Related Services originally specified in Section V, Price Schedule.

35. Notification of Award

35.1 Prior to the expiration of the period of bid validity, the Sri Lanka Cricket shall notify the successful Bidder, in writing, that its Bid has been accepted.
