## **BANDULA WARNAPURA** (1975 - 1982)

**Opening batsman with a solid technique**, Warnapura entered the national team in **1972** as a schoolboy. He was also a useful allrounder, an able leader and Sri Lanka gained Test tatus during his captaincy. The pinnacle of his career was when he was appointed to lead Sri Lanka against England in the inaugural Test match in 1982. His illustrious playing career ended when he participated in a rebel tour to aparthied South Africa in October 1982.
